Introduction

This one day qualification teaches learners how non-complex incidents can be investigated effectively. By learning lessons and making improvements, organisations can avoid similar incidents occurring in the future and improve their company's safety performance.

Online Course

The Online course is based on a maintenance incident scenario. The classroom and virtual courses may be based around office, maintenance or warehouse environments. Regardless of learning method, learners are required to watch three witness interviews associated with the incident, examine other information to this incident, and complete the assessment paperwork.

Who is the course for?

This course is for anyone who wants to carry out incident investigations effectively. Employers, supervisors, SHE champions, union and safety representatives will benefit.
