



Halloween Safety Tips

Slips & Trips

Identify & control potential trip hazards around your property, especially those that are difficult to see after dark e.g extension cords, plant pots, water hoses

Electrical Safety

- ◆ Don't overload plug sockets or extension cables with decorations
- ◆ Don't leave decorations on for too long to avoid overheating
- ◆ Always read the manufacturers instructions & guidance



Fire Safety

Avoid any kind of open flames and consider using battery-operated candles or LED lighting as a safe alternative

Always check the manufacturer's guidance to help avoid damage to your home and guests - keep flammable decorations and costumes away from ignition sources
